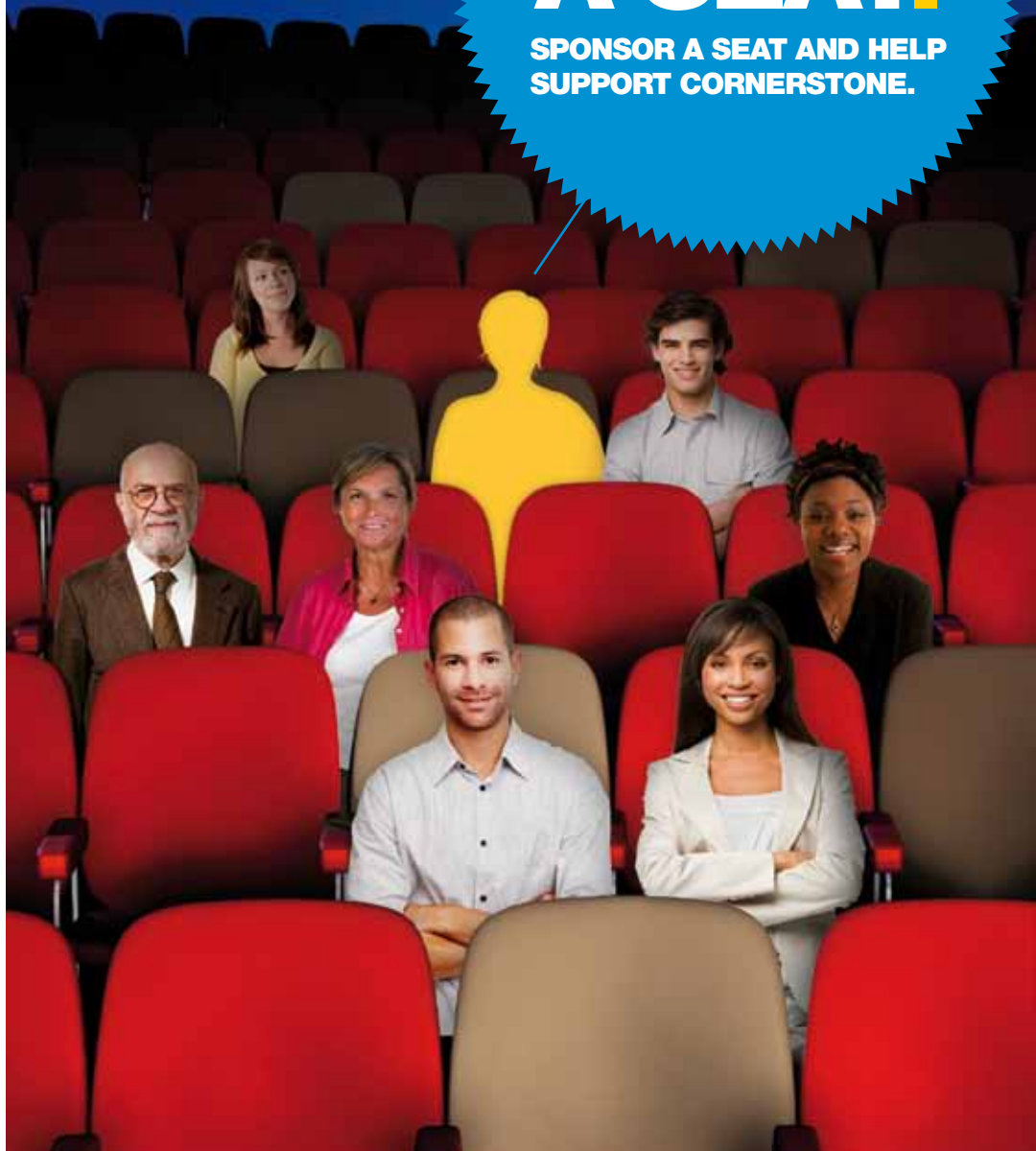

Cornerstone is South Oxfordshire District Council's professional arts and entertainment venue.

Opened in August 2008, Cornerstone has a seated auditorium for drama, music, dance, comedy and children's shows plus exhibition and workshop spaces, studios, rooms for hire and a thriving café/bar restaurant.

Welcoming over 150,000 visitors since opening, Cornerstone is now offering the chance to sponsor a seat in its 224 seat auditorium.

You can play an important part in supporting this exciting new arts venue by naming a seat for yourself, a family member, a business or a group.

Naming a seat is also a lovely way to:

- **Celebrate** an anniversary or achievement, or the arrival of a new child
- **Commemorate** a special loved one - In Memoriam

- **Show** corporate support or community involvement from your business

Whatever your reason may be, we invite you to dedicate a seat and support Cornerstone.

How much does it cost?

It's £200 for three years and your gift will be acknowledged by:

- a **plaque** fixed to the back of a seat inscribed with the wording of your choice (maximum of 80 characters including spaces)
- a **listing** as a seat sponsor on our website (unless you choose to remain anonymous)
- a **gift** of a commemorative certificate
- an **exclusive** invitation to our Sponsor a Seat unveiling party, if your gift is made by 31 March 2011.

You are welcome to specify a particular seat to sponsor if you wish, though you do not have to, and we will make every effort to accommodate your wish. However, sponsoring a seat does not mean that this seat will be available each time you make a ticket booking.

All gifts go towards running the future artistic and participation programme at Cornerstone.
