## **Belinda Ellis**

10 December – 17 January

Inspired by travels in places as diverse as the Outer Hebrides, Mongolia, China and Japan, Belinda has created abstract work in acrylics and watercolours.

Working intuitively, Belinda uses differing or opposing elements, such as accident and order, translucence and opacity or stillness and energy to create these large canvases and prints.

### **3+3 Collaborative Art: Different Passions Lendon Scantlebury, Dawn Benson and Stuart Roper**

21 January – 7 March

Three artists who work together and individually, come together for this exhibition which includes oils, acrylics, watercolours, drawings, mixed media and sculpture.

Their combined energy has allowed them to develop and explore the dynamics of their individual passions with an intended result of interesting juxtapositions in styles and themes.

Lendon's work is about people, interactions, relationships, beaches and atmosphere.

His style is dry brush acrylics, wild and expressive – impressionistic.

Dawn's passions are sculptural – the relationships between people and horses in a stylised form, produced in bronze and resin. Paintings of landscapes in various media are atmospheric and mood driven.

Stuart has a passion for the human form, architecture and landscapes. His pen portraits show people in everyday encounters. Light, fresh and clear work in various media, including pen and wash and oils.
